It is with pleasure that I am writing a letter of recommendation for Illia Barger.

Iliya design and installed a “four wall” mural in a day care facility sponsored by the New York City Economic Development Corporation (EDC) and the Agency for Child Development (ACD). The day care center is located in the Brooklyn Army Terminal which has been converted for industrial uses; the allocated “play area” within the day care center is an awkward space that is 20 feet wide by 55 feet long by 35 feet high. Iliya previewed the space and conceived of the “aquatic” scheme to fill up this vast area. She prepared an impressive model that showed what the mural would look like in the space and was able to persuade a diverse group of city bureaucrats to fund the project.
